Seasons Center Receives \$7,000 Grant from the O'Brien County Community Foundation

SPENCER – Seasons Center for Behavioral Health has received a \$7,000 grant from the O'Brien County Community Foundation/Siouxland Community Foundation. The funding will be used to purchase outdoor playground equipment for Camp Autumn, a therapeutic camp for children, located at 4233 Yew Avenue in Sutherland, Iowa. Camp Autumn, an extension of Autumn's Center, a regional children's center located in Spencer, Iowa, served over 140 children through nine weeks of summer day camps in 2017 and has over 200 children registered this year.

"We are grateful to the O'Brien County Community Foundation for their continued support of Camp Autumn," said Christina Eggink-Postma, Vice President of Program Coordination and Compliance at Seasons. "Research supports the positive outcomes when children have access to the outdoors and physical activity, and we have already seen the many benefits of this for the children that we're serving at Camp Autumn."

The day camps at Camp Autumn include group therapy, skill development, and structured activities to help the children in their healing.

"Having a playground will offer additional outdoor activities for children to be engaged in and enjoy, while also providing positive sensory stimulation and increased opportunities for peer interaction."
