



Internship Program

Goal

Our internship program is dedicated to supporting, developing and training clinical psychology doctoral interns who, after successful completion of the internship program, will be able to effectively practice clinical psychology. Interns will be expected to work approximately 40-45 hours per week and are required to accrue 2000 hours to successfully complete the internship program.

Primary Services

Interns are required to engage in and complete primary services. These services are conducted continuously throughout the year. Primary Services for interns include:

- *Individual Therapy* – Individual therapy services are provided for children, adolescents, and adults for a wide variety of presenting concerns
- *Psychological Testing* – Testing batteries can include neuropsychological, developmental, psychoeducational, and personality assessments for children, adolescents, and adults
- *Supervision* – Interns will have a minimum of two (2) hours of individual supervision by a licensed psychologist and two (2) hours of group supervision a week
- *Didactic Trainings* – Interns will attend approximately two (2) hours of training a week

**Various optional services may also be included in the internship.*
