## **Seasons Center Releases Annual Audit**

**Spencer, IA.** – Seasons Center for Behavioral Health released their annual audit report for FY 2022. Seasons Center's revenue increased by 10% compared to FY 2021. Expenses increased by 10% compared to FY 2021. Net assets increased \$1,405,003 during FY 2022 to \$3,354,022, a 72% increase compared to FY 2021.
