Seasons Center Awarded Grant Funds from the Iowa Attorney General's Office, Crime Victim Assistance Division

SPENCER – On May 6, 2016, the State of Iowa, Crime Victim Assistance Board, voted to award Seasons Center with nearly \$400,000 in Victim Services Support Program (VSS) funds to expand services to crime victims not previously served, underserved, or not accessing traditional victim services.

"We are excited and grateful to be chosen as a recipient of these grant funds," says Kim Scorza, Executive Director, for Seasons. "This funding will allow us to better partner with well-established victim services agencies in providing therapy to their clients, as well as training and resources to victim service agencies employees."

The proposed project will be both an expansion of existing behavioral health services provided by Seasons and the implementation of new program services. The service area will encompass 19 counties in northwest Iowa: Buena Vista, Calhoun, Carroll, Cherokee, Clay, Crawford, Dickinson, Emmet, Ida, Lyon, Monona, O'Brien, Osceola, Palo Alto, Plymouth, Pocahontas, Sac, Sioux, and Woodbury. With this funding, Seasons will hire four Trauma Therapists, dedicated to the implementation of program services and activities.

Seasons is a non-profit organization and has been providing a broad range of psychiatric and behavioral health services to people and communities in Northwest lowa since 1959. Seasons strives to provide exceptional care to children, families, and adults through skilled, dedicated, and passionate employees who use evidence-based treatment practices and innovative treatment techniques.
